First, this patio roof not only provides shade but also creates a cozy outdoor room and destination. Most homes have only a cramped covered patio attached to the back of the house. Introducing a shade feature in the landscape draws you out into the space. Steel posts, aluminum lattice, ceiling fan, bistro lights, furniture, metal trellises with vines, pots, and a travertine patio all work together to create a pleasant place to enjoy day or evening.



Next, this BBQ grill, pizza oven and griddle combine to offer a variety of cooking options. Complete with a concrete countertop, stone veneer walls and plenty of cabinet space, this outdoor cook center is a great focal feature for dining and entertaining.



The water feature in the third photo was designed to integrate into the landscape and provide a pleasant focal point nestled among *Salvia farinacea* and Blue Elf Aloe. The subtle sound of water trickling down the three-piece basalt stones creates a relaxing environment to sit and watch the hummingbirds and butterflies, which are attracted to the water and flowers.

Finally, this simple steel cylindrical gas fire feature is the perfect spot to sit around on our cool fall evenings, which are just around the corner.
